At a Seattle fundraiser on Sunday, Democratic vice-presidential nominee Joe Biden warned supporters that, if elected, Barack Obama will be tested by "an international crisis" early on in his first term. He also advised the crowd to "gird your loins," since the tasks ahead for the next president will be "like cleaning the Augean stables, man." What's the best way to follow Biden's advice? With a belt. To gird means to bind or encircle, and loins refers to the area between your hips and ribs. (Note: In this case, loins does not refer to the genitals, as with Nabokov's "light of my life, fire of my loins.") So, "to gird your loins" means, literally, to wrap a belt around your waist so that your clothes don't flop around. The phrase stems from the Bible and is scattered throughout both the Old and New Testaments—composed during notoriously floppy sartorial eras. When Elijah "girded up his loins" (1 Kings 18:46), he was probably wearing a knee-length robe. It's likely that he fastened a cord tightly around his waist, then shortened his garment by pulling it up and letting it flounce over the belt. Or he might have taken the hem of his robe and tucked it into his belt, creating a makeshift pouch or pocket. Romans prepping for a fight also needed to gird their loins. Especially if he needed to ride a horse, a Roman might have gathered up the skirtlike portion of his outfit, passed it through his legs, and fastened the whole mess with a girdle (a leather belt, basically, also used to hold tools or weapons). Biden, of course, was advising his supporters to gird their loins in the figurative sense—that is, to brace themselves for a test of mental or emotional endurance. He was perhaps unintentionally echoing the apostle Peter, who recommended "girding up the loins of your mind ... and [setting] your hope perfectly on the grace that is to be brought unto you at the revelation of Jesus Christ" (1 Peter 1:13). Why do you/we need to gird up our loins? What is the benefit? How do we practically gird up our loins? If you haven't heard of "gird up your loins with truth", don't worry, be happy, keep your mind open, buckle up, get a drink and I'll sort you out. Especially a cleansing prayer (for no man is without sin) and humbly ask the Holy Spirit to educate you so that you lean not on your own understanding. Approach your bible study sessions with a humble, hungry and genuinely curious spirit, to unlock its wondrous power. This way, you will look and see. Hear and understand. Discern. You will advance from milk to solid food, the power of the scripture, based on my own experience, will meet you at your level of maturity spiritually. The more you mature diligently and proactively, the more you will know and each time, you will uncover different profound meanings in just one scripture which will be of benefit to your life and decisions. Meaning your strength is found in Christ Jesus and the power of His might. Not yours. Which also reminds me of Jesus example in the book of Hebrews. Where actually, people have twisted the scripture by virtue of thinking it was a mistake when it reads "...and upholds all things by the word of His power" whereby they argue that it ought to have been "...by the power of His word" which is wrong. The scripture means exactly what is written and "by the word of His power" means Jesus upheld all things by the word of God's power then what of us? We too gain our strength in Christ Jesus, the strength of His power which is upheld by the word of God's power. No wonder, man shall not live by bread alone but by ever word that comes from the full armor of God, so that you will be able to stand firm against the schemes of the devil". Stand firm according to the dictionary means to refuse to change a decision or position whereas a scheme means, making plans deviously, with an attempt to do something wrong or illegal. So then this means if we walk around spiritually naked without the full armor of God or gaining strength from Christ's strength of His power which is upheld by God, then we are vulnerable to attacks that might not be so evident to us in the physical and if we want to be able to detect when we are in a danger zone unknowingly and deal with the situation firmly, we need to rely on Christ Jesus who relies on the power of God's word.
